a) International Education Committee, 11/14/13, Andrew Dell-Olio:

The International Education Committee met on Thursday, November 14. Andrew Dell'Olio was appointed the new Chair of the committee after Gwenda Schmidt needed to step down for health reasons. The committee discussed the desirability of revising the essay portion of the off-campus study application to reflect the five Global Learning outcomes. The committee also discussed the need for clarity with regard to the proper oversight for students wishing to apply for internships in off-campus programs. We will seek more coordination with Registrar's Office and Career Services. The question of how to streamline the process of evaluating transfer credits for study abroad programs arose. This issue will be discussed further at a subsequent meeting.

b) The Curriculum Committee Meeting took place on Thursday November 21, 2013, at 11:00 a.m. in Martha Miller.

The committee considered 4 proposals and all were approved:

1. Honors program in history, History Department: The substance for the proposal for a History Honors Program includes completing an approved co-curricular experience and completing a senior honors project. It does not require additional courses. It does require additional work by faculty without compensation but much of this is being done already.
2. Revise the major and minor, History Department: Categories of courses were changed to include at least one course from the AAMELA (Africa, Asia, Middle East or Latin America) global courses category and the distribution of 200 level and 300 level courses was slightly revised. The restriction that no more than three courses at the 100 level now includes HIST 207 and HIST 208.
3. Two new courses, Communication Department (Intergroup Dialogue and Intergroup Dialogue Practicum)
4. Split an existing course (COMM 371 Intercultural and Gender Communication) into two separate courses (Intercultural Communication: Communicating Across Differences, and Gender Communication.)
